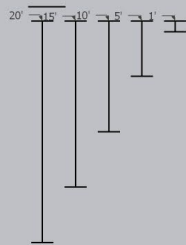
Story

Flower Arrangements pt 2.

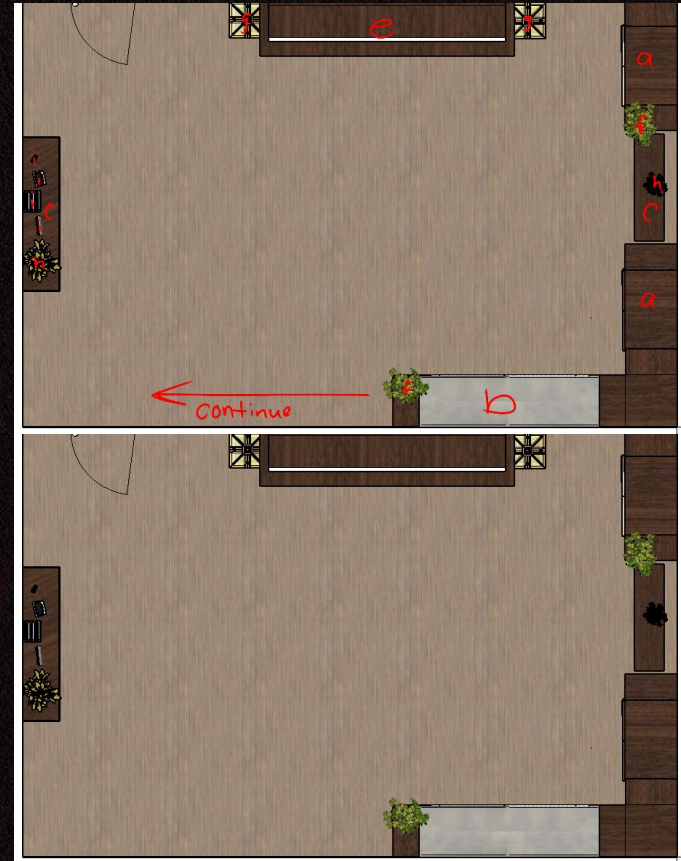
In one of the sample coffins you will find a pamphlet on birth flowers.

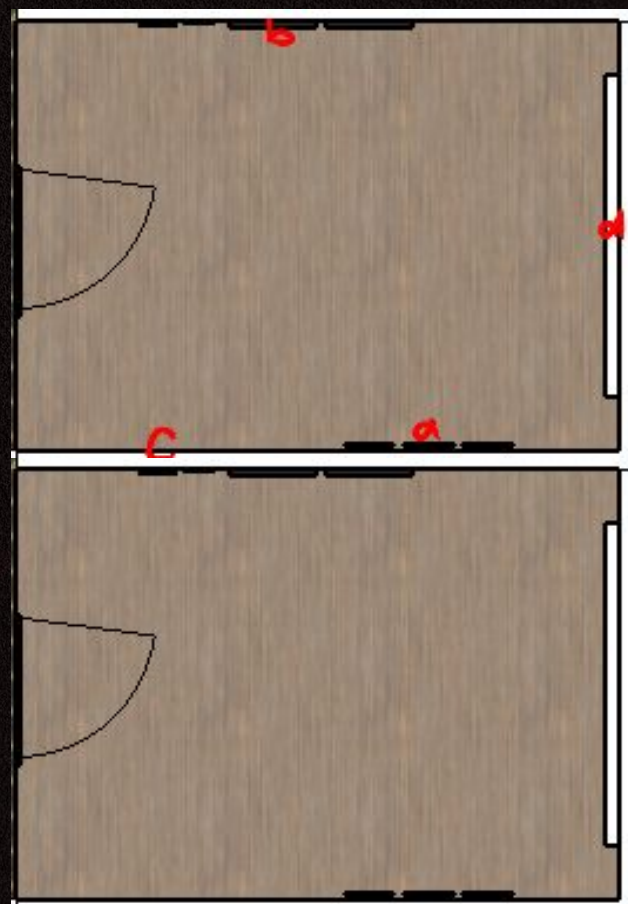
Picture Puzzle

Mix what you need

There are cabinets with embalming fluid in them.
There is a label on one of the cases that says
“MIX WHAT YOU NEED”.

There is a poster on the wall that says **“A true embalmer knows that the right combination of fluids can not only preserve the body but also the spirits journey to the afterlife”**.

- On your flashlight there will be a black light setting

- If you shine that blacklight to the poster it will reveal instead of the last quote it now says **“A skilled embalmer knows the right combination of fluids can preserve not only the body but the secrets it holds”**.

- This will point you to needing the embalming fluids.

There is a note in one of the drawers on that note is an order list of what fluids need to be bought.

- If you shine the black light on the page certain letters will be highlighted in the ink.
(3). They will be labeled either with a, b, or c.

On the embalming machine there will be three lines on each there will be a labeled number either a,b, or c.

- Fill up the assigned chemical to the designated line and a number will be revealed. That is your second number.



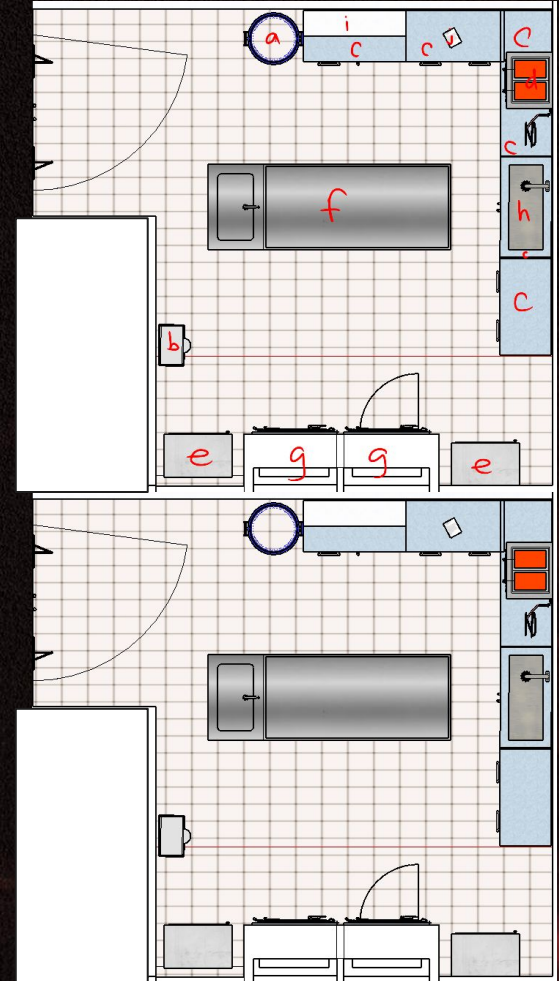
The Body Freezer

On a shelf you will find a bloody scrap of paper detailing the process of head transference and resurrection.

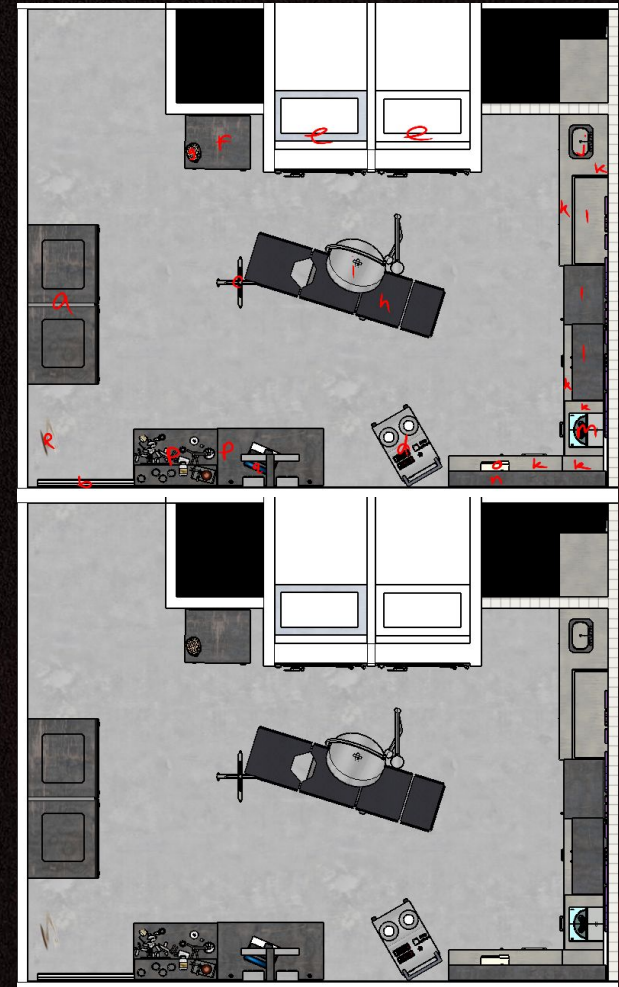

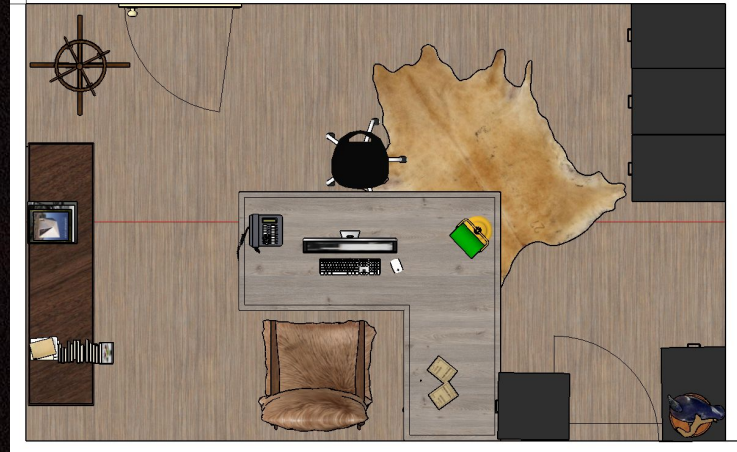
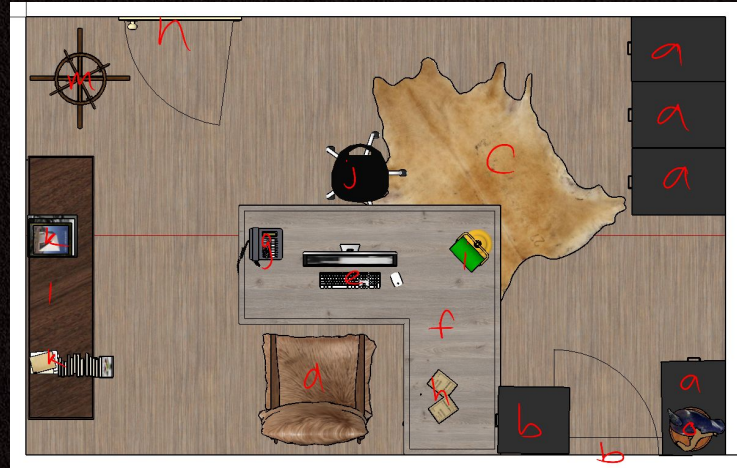
The Severed Hands

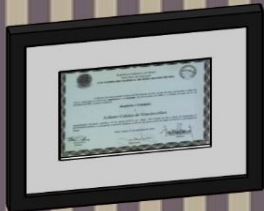


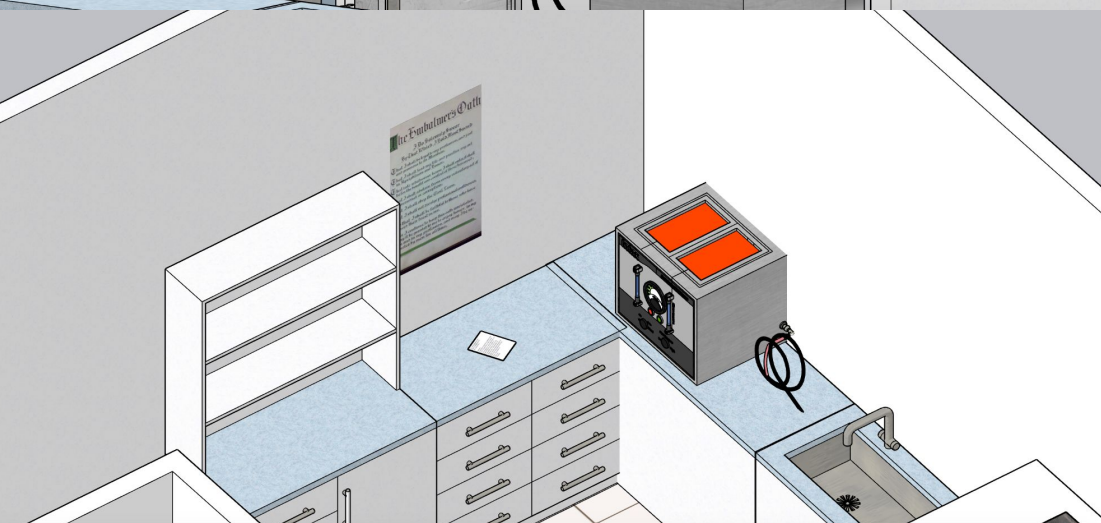
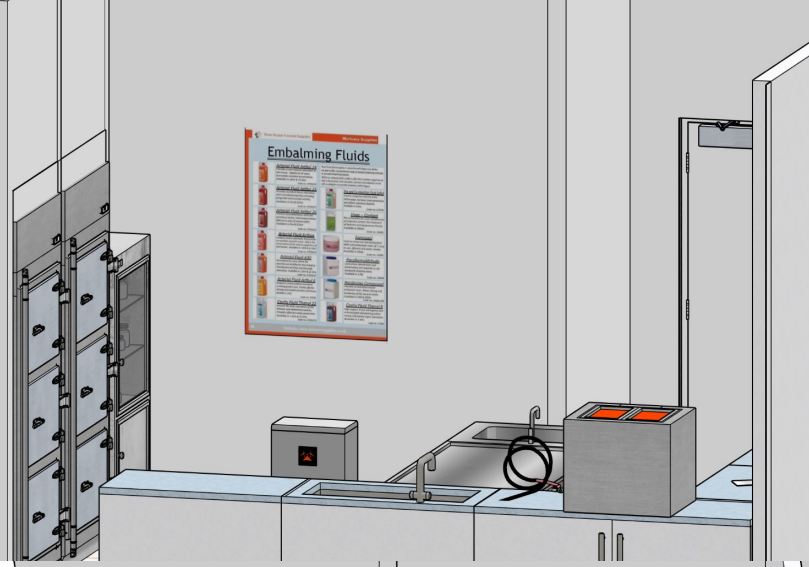
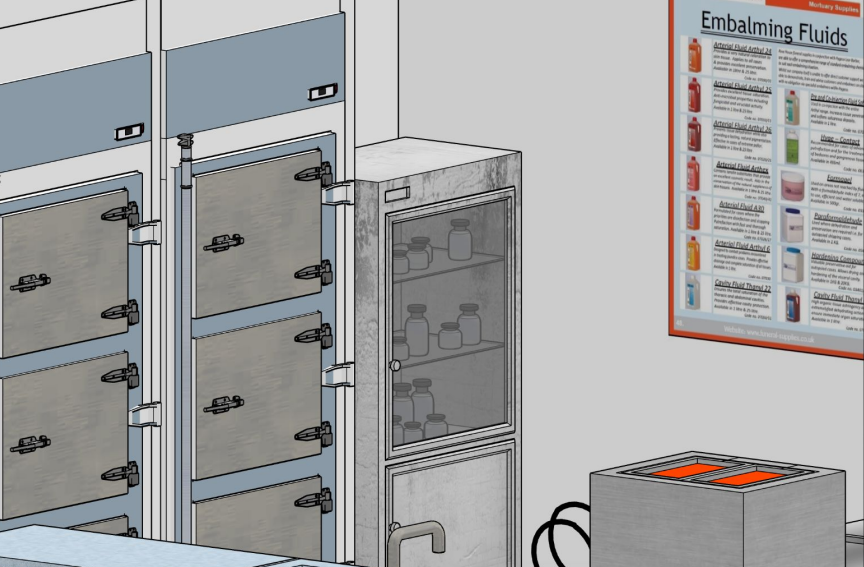




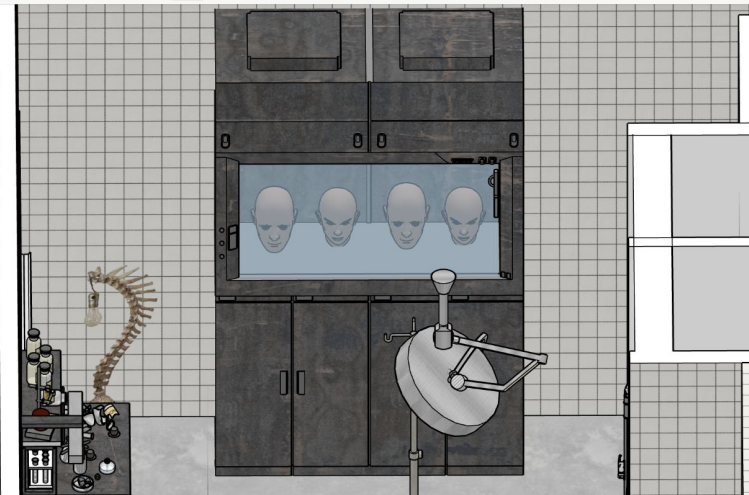


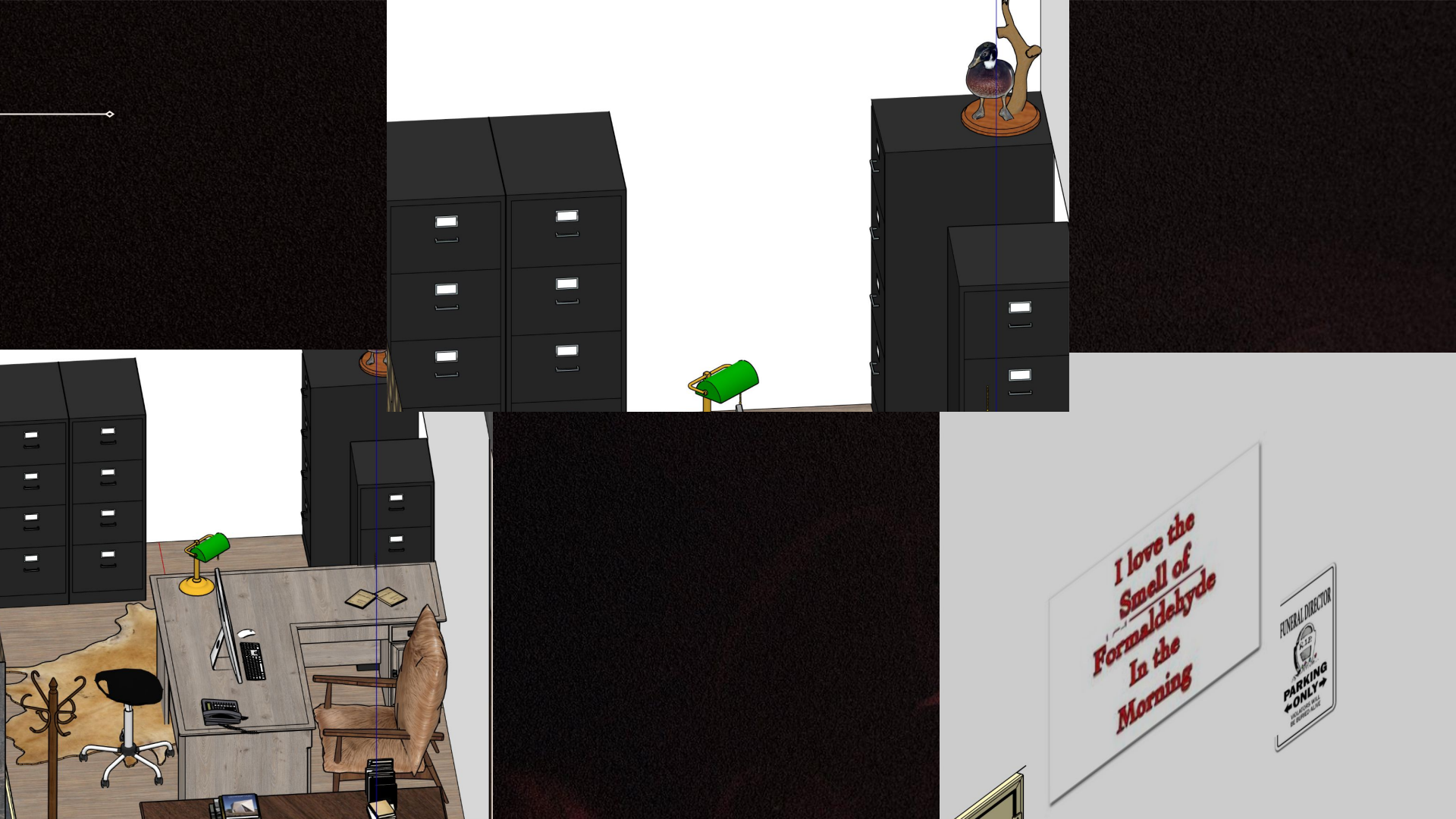
Funeral Directors

And gently help us find our way.











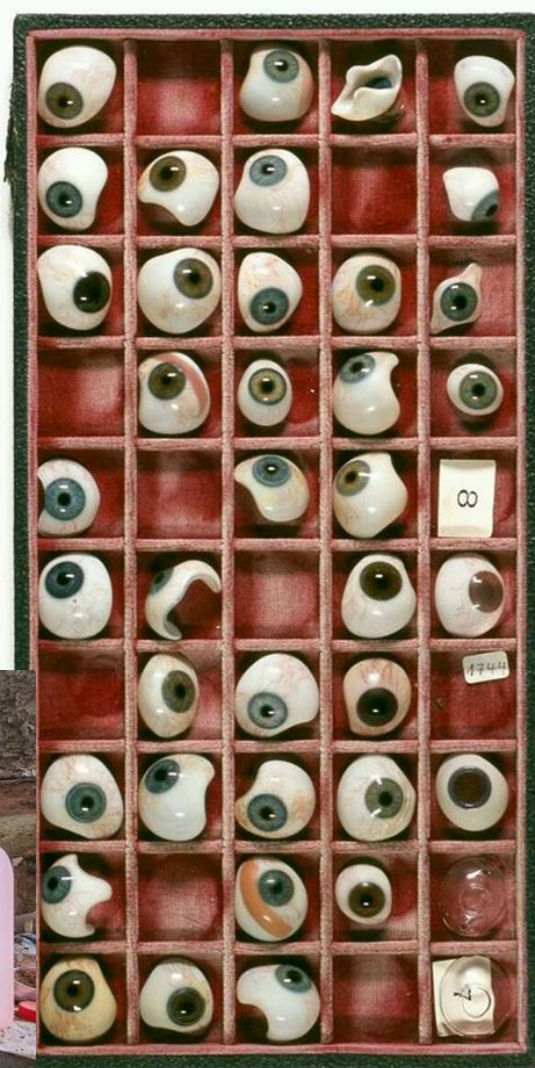
